Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for handing over the investigation of case FIR No.181 dated 19.10.2015, under Sections 377, 506, 292(2), 295 and 120-B IPC and under Section 67 of the Information Technology Act, 2000, registered at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar (Rural) to some independent agency including the Crime Branch.

Admittedly, the petitioner has approached this Court without making any representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not press this

petition, however, seek permission to withdraw this petition to enable him to move an appropriate representation before the authorities concerned.

Dismissed as withdrawn. However, in case the petitioner moves such representation within one month from today, respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) shall take into consideration the same and shall act in accordance with law.
