Challenge in this petition is to the order dated 19.11.2014 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Patiala, whereby on a revision filed against the order dated 01.07.2014 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Patiala, the interim maintenance granted to the respondents has been modified.

On an application made by Gagandeep Kaur wife of Randeep Singh (petitioner herein) under Section 125 Cr.P.C., the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Patiala, vide order dated 01.07.2014, had granted interim maintenance of Rs.7000/- per month (Rs.5000/- per month to respondent No.1-wife and Rs.2000/- per month to minor son-respondent No.2) from the date of application. On revision filed by the present petitioner (husband), the maintenance has been reduced to Rs.4000/- per month to the wife and Rs.2000/- to the minor child.

that there was no document on the file to prove the income of husband-petitioner.

The income of the petitioner can be taken to be that of a daily wager, which comes to about Rs.12,000/- per month. Out of this income, ad-interim maintenance of Rs.6000/- per month i.e. Rs.4000/- per month to respondent No.1-wife and Rs.2000/- per month to minor son-respondent No.2 has been reasonably awarded by the Court below. The maintenance awarded is not on the higher side. Hence, no ground is made out to interfere in the impugned order.

Dismissed.
