KULDIP SINGH, J (ORAL)

This order will dispose of two criminal petitions bearing CRM-M-5503-2016 and CRM-M-5517-2016, being the version and cross version. Both the petitions have been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (in short 'Cr.P.C') for quashing of FIR No. 36 dated 30.04.2015

(Annexure P-1) in CRM-M-5503-2016, registered under Sections 324, 323, and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (in short 'IPC') registered at Police Station Ghuman, District Batala and cross case DDR No. 28, dated 30.04.2015 (Annexure P-2) in CRM-M-5517-2016, registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 427, 447, 379, 511, 148 and 149 of IPC at Police Station Ghuman, District Batala along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 22.12.2015 (Annexure P-3).

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Batala is received to the effect that she has recorded the statements of the complainant as well as the accused in both the cases and has reported that the compromise has been effected between the parties and the same is genuine and without any pressure.

In view of the compromise effected between the parties, FIR No.36 dated 30.04.2015, under Sections 324, 323, and 34 of IPC registered at Police Station Ghuman, District Batala and cross case DDR No. 28, dated 30.04.2015, under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 427, 447, 379, 511, 148 and 149 of IPC along with all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom stand quashed.

Both the petitions are allowed, accordingly.
