JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents No. 5 to 7 and to direct respondent No.3 to decide the representation (Annexure P-1).

2. Notice to respondents No.1 to 4 only, at this stage.

3. On the asking of Court, Mr. Tanuj Sharma, AAG, Haryana, has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though a representation dated February 05, 2016 was submitted to respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Hisar but no action has been taken so far. Rather,

the police is harassing the petitioner at the instance of private respondents.

5. The instant petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.3- Superintendent of Police, Hisar to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in her representation dated 05.02.2016 (Annexure P-1) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
