Application is allowed, as prayed for.

Main Petition

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C.,
petitioner has sought quashing of FIR No. 322, dated 20.07.2008, under

Sections 324, 323, 201 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Patiala, District Patiala (Annexure P-1) and all other consequential proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of compromise dated 18.12.2015 (Annexure P-2)

Though, the statements of parties in respect of compromise have been recorded and a report in this regard has been received from learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Patiala. A perusal of report reveals that during proceedings petitioner was declared proclaimed offender by learned trial Court vide order dated May 12, 2014 and since then, he is absconding and is at large.

Thus, in view of the fact that petitioner is a proclaimed offender and is evading his arrest, instant petition seeking quashing of above-said FIR and all consequential proceedings arising out of the said FIR is not maintainable.

Accordingly, it stands dismissed.
