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ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR no.256 dated 11.12.2015 registered under Sections 343, 366, 376-D, 34 IPC at Police Station Bahin, District Palwal.

Heard.

The petitioner is the husband of the complainant. A matrimonial dispute arose and the complainant went back to her family. The allegations are that she was forcibly kidnapped and was confined and beaten up. The allegations are that her father in law and brother in law (Jeth) committed rape upon her. The allegations were also made that she was confined and kept without food for a number

of days. It was the police who came to her rescue. She was taken before a Magistrate and a statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C. had been recorded. The father in law and the brother in law could not be arrested.

It had been urged on behalf of the petitioner that the complainant had given an affidavit supporting them in the Court and it was under the pressure of her father that the FIR was got registered and the father was trying to get her married for the second time, for money.

The complainant has levelled serious allegations against the husband and his brother and father in law. She has made a statement in the Court and she has also explained as to why she had made a statement earlier. The allegations are serious. No case for anticipatory bail is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
