Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Aslam in case FIR No.0207 dated 2.9.2015 P.S. Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar for offences punishable under Animal Preservation 1 Act, 1954, Act, 1860, 473, 279, 336, 307, 420 of Indian Penal Code and Punjab Prohibition 4B of Cow Slaughter Act, 1955, The Punjab Prohibition 8 of Cow Slaughter Act, 1955.

Police has intercepted a truck on 2.9.2015 at about 2.30 am containing 6 cows and 8 oxen loaded in a cruel manner and in the process transporting them to the State of Uttar Pradesh for the purpose of slaughter.

The accused are alleged to have run away and the petitioner has been

arraigned as accused being owner of the truck.

It is contended that petitioner had since 15.7.2015 (P-1) relinquished his right to manage the truck in favour of one Aslam Khan and, therefore, has nothing to do with the said offence. It is further submitted that he is not involved in any other case.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel assisted by ASI Rajpal submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 08th of January, 2016 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
