On the instructions of ASI Mukhtiar Singh, learned State counsel informs that though the petitioner has only been attributed the simple injuries but he is involved in 15 other criminal cases during the last 6-7 years.

Since the grievous injury is attributed to the co-accused of the petitioner, he can be granted concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that petitioner will be required to furnish an affidavit before his release to the effect that he will not indulge in similar activity of which he is accused of, during pendency of the trial.
