Petitioners seek benefit of regular bail in case FIR No.175 dated 26.11.2015, under Sections 379-B-I of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar Rural.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Ranjit Kaur. Accusations are pertaining to an occurrence dated 26.11.2015 when two clean shaven young boys came on a motorcycle while the complainant was going on a rickshaw and snatched her purse containing Rs.3000/-. The two boys were apprehended by the passersby on the spot who revealed their identity as Ramandeep alias Baba and Rajbir Singh i.e. present petitioners.

Petitioners have been in custody since 26.11.2015.

State counsel upon instructions from ASI Jaswant Singh would submit that the investigation in the matter is still underway.

Be that as it may, it is not the case made out on behalf of the State that if benefit of bail is granted to the petitioners, they would be in a position to influence or hamper the course of investigation.

It has also gone uncontroverted that the petitioners otherwise are not involved in any other criminal proceedings.

Without making any observations on merit, petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.
