Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 CrPC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.126 dated 30.9.2015 under Sections 323/324/148/149/506 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Balachaur, District SBS Nagar.

Vide order dated 1.4.2016, this Court has granted interim bail to the petitioner subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer and compliance of provisions of 438(2) CrPC.

Learned State counsel submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required in the present case.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 1.4.2016 passed by this Court is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) CrPC.
