Prayer in this application is for placing on record copy of order dated 18.5.2015 of this Court, copy of petition under Section 125 Cr.PC filed by the complainant and statement of the complainant (PW1) as Annexures P-2 to P-4 respectively.

For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed and the documents Annexures P-2 to P-4 are taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

CRM-M-5591-2016

This is second petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. filed by petitioner Karamjeet wife of Gur Singh for grant of regular bail to her in case FIR No.112 dated 11.2.2015 under Sections 109, 120-B, 372, 373, 342 and 506 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Hisar, District Hisar (Challan presented under Sections 109, 120-B, 506, 343, 370 and 370(A)(1) IPC).

The allegations against the petitioner are that she has brought Rajni from Patiala and made her to solemnise marriage with Bharat Bhushan with consideration of Rs.1,00,000/-.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 11.2.2015 and the other co-accused, namely, Raj Bala, Bharat Bhushan and Gurtej have already been granted regular bail by this Court. The only role attributed to the petitioner is that she instigated other co-accused Gurtej to sell Rajni to Bharat Bhushan.

On the other hand, learned State counsel has opposed the prayer of petitioner by contending that it is a very serious matter of human trafficking where women are being sold for money. He submits that there are serious allegations against the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

There is no dispute that co-accused, namely, Raj Bala, Bharat Bhushan and Gurtej have been granted regular bail by this Court. The petitioner is in custody since 11.2.2015. Challan has already been presented

in the Court. As informed by learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Amar Singh, that as against 13 witnesses, 8 witnesses have already been examined by the prosecution. This Court feels that conclusion of trial will take sufficient long time.

In view of these facts and circumstances, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is admitted to bail subject to her furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

However, the observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression on the merits of the case and the trial Court shall be at liberty to decide the case on the basis of availability of evidence.
