Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of SI Jaspal Singh alleging that on 16.01.2015 a telephone call was received from ASI Harkesh Singh informing that Lawrence Bishnoi had absconded from police custody while on his way back to District Jail Ropar from Court. Co-accused of the petitioner with whom he had entered into a conspiracy to get the said accused released, has been granted concession of bail.

All the co-accused of the petitioner have been granted concession of bail as per the information gathered by State counsel from HC Palwinder Singh.

The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 04.04.2015. No witness having been examined during the entire period of custody, he can be granted concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that he will not indulge in similar activity of which he is accused of during pendency of the trial.

In case of violation of above said condition, this order will be deemed to have been cancelled.
