Report dated 07.04.2016 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Bathinda has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Raveena @ Rubina Singh and Priya @ Preeti as well as of complainant Vijay Kumar it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view the same and the fact that parties have effected a compromise for the offences which are not of heinous nature which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052,** FIR No.21 dated 03.04.2012 under Sections 420, 120B IPC Police Station, Nathana, District Bathinda and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present

petitioners.
