JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to take action on the complaint (Annexure P-6) submitted by the petitioner by lodging FIR against respondents No. 4 to 17 because of them the life and liberty of the petitioner and his property is in danger.

2. Notice to respondents No.1 to 3 only, at this stage.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. Rajpreet Singh Sidhu, AAG, Punjab, has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case direction is given to respondent No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded

by petitioner in his representation (Annexure P-6).

5. The instant petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into the grievances unfolded by petitioner in his representation dated 07.02.2016 (Annexure P-6) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
