Both the parties are present in Court today and have stated that the matter has been compromised in the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. The copy of the settlement dated 23.12.2015 (*Annexure P-5*) has been filed.

It comes out that there was a matrimonial dispute between the petitioner and his wife. Respondent No. 2 is the brother-in-law of the petitioner. Now, the matrimonial dispute between the petitioner and his wife is stated to be amicably settled and they are living in Kerala.

In the present case, there are allegations that the petitioner has caused some injury to respondent No. 2. The perusal of the settlement of the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court shows that the parties have agreed to get the present FIR No. 299 dated 28.10.2014 (*Annexure P-1*) registered under Sections 452, 323, 427, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station Cantonment, District Amritsar City, quashed by making statement.

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Respondent No. 2 present in Court, also confirms about the settlement of the Mediation Conciliation Centre of this Court.

In view of the said settlement dated 23.12.2015 before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court (*Annexure P-5*) between the parties, the FIR No. 299 dated 28.10.2014 (*Annexure P-1*) registered under Sections 452, 323, 427, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station Cantonment, District Amritsar City stands quashed alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

In view of the above, the present petition stands allowed.
