This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0065 dated 13.02.2015 registered under Sections 365 IPC and Section 4 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has falsely been implicated in the case whereas no offence is made out. As per secondary school examination certificate, the date of birth of petitioner is 14.10.1997. The petitioner is in custody since 13.02.2015 and no useful purpose will be served in case the petitioner is kept behind the bars.

Learned State counsel submits that all prosecution witnesses have been examined except one and the date before trial Court is fixed for 20.07.2016.

Keeping in view the stage of the trial and seriousness of offence, no ground is made out to grant regular bail to the petitioner.

The petition is dismissed.
