1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?

JASPAL SINGH, J.

Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking quashing of FIR No.129, dated 08.05.2014, under Sections 451 subsequently added Section 451(1), 147, 149 IPC, Police Station Sector 36, Chandigarh (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising thereof, on the basis of compromise dated 28.01.2016 (Annexure P-2).

2. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate has been received,

in which, it has been categorically observed that the parties have settled the matter voluntarily, without any pressure/coercion from any quarter. Even otherwise, the matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest. Compromise is the soul of justice, which not only enhances the social amity, harmony and peace but also reduces friction and discord.

3. So, in view of above circumstances, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, the instant petition stands allowed and FIR No.129, dated 08.05.2014, under Sections 451 subsequently added Section 451(1), 147, 149 IPC, Police Station Sector 36, Chandigarh and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
