Challan has already been presented in a case of petitioner along with Ravinder Singh and Tajinder Kumar having received a total sum of Rs.24.5 lacs on the pretext of getting admission of the daughter of the complainant - Daljit Singh in medical college. The complainant was duped and persuaded to part money by handing over fake documents on different occasions. Even fake E-mails purported to have been sent from the Medical College authorities, were sent by the petitioner. Chances of tampering with the evidence or threatening the witnesses cannot be ruled out in the present case. No ground is made out to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed at this stage, without prejudice to the right of the petitioner to approach this Court after recording of statement of some witnesses or on any settlement between the complainant and the petitioner regarding discharging of the liability of the petitioner to any extent.
