For having been found in possession of 60 Kg of poppy husk,
the petitioner has been custody w.e.f. 19.12.2012.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the quantity recovered
from the petitioner is marginally higher than the commercial quantity
prescribed.

The petitioner, in the said circumstances, can be granted the
concession of bail. But in view of the fact that petitioner is involved in four
cases of similar nature under the NDPS Act and trial is at the stage of
recording defence evidence, this petition is dismissed.

It is not out of place to observe here that this is the fifth petition
seeking concession of regular bail. Taking into consideration the period of
detention suffered by the petitioner, it is observed that trial Court shall make
earnest endeavor to conclude the case within the period of two months after
the receipt of copy of the order.
