Prayer in this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, is for grant of anticipatory bail on behalf of the accused/petitioner-Shyam Lal alias Shyam Sunder in case FIR No. 26, dated 23.01.2016, for offences punishable under Sections 148, 149, 323, 506, Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Nangal Chaudhary, District Mahendergarh, Haryana.

It was submitted that wife of the complainant and present petitioner were contesting elections from Ward No. 18 for the election of the Block Development Committee.

It was contended that false case has been foisted upon the petitioner due to political rivalry. That apart, even the alleged injuries are simple in nature and alleged offence under Section 506 IPC is only non-bailable.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to order dated 17.02.2016, passed by this Court, the petitioner has since joined the

investigation and fully cooperated.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Jaswant Singh, does not refute the aforesaid factual position and further states that the petitioner is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted to the petitioner by this Court's order dated 17.02.2016, is made absolute.
