JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 10, dated January 25, 2016, under Sections 452, 323, 379, 148 & 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur (**Annexure P-1**) along with all consequential proceedings arising out of the same on the basis of compromise dated February 03, 2016 (**Annexure P-2**).

2. In compliance of order dated February 17, 2016, statement of the parties have been recorded by the trial Court. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Dhuri, has been

received, in which, it has been categorically observed that the matter has been compromised between the parties without any pressure, coercion and the same appears to be genuine. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 10, dated January 25, 2016, under Sections 452, 323, 379, 148 & 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur (**Annexure P-1**) and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
