Prayer in this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, is for grant of anticipatory bail on behalf of the accused/petitioner- Raj Singh in case FIR No. 21, dated 23.01.2016, for offences punishable under Sections 147, 149, 323, 325, 506, Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Furrukhnagar, District Gurgaon.

There are allegations of petitioner accused alongwith his co-accused family members having trespassed into the house of the complainant-prosecutrix on 19.1.2016 at about 8.30 pm and while misbehaving with her alleged to have caused injuries to her and her husband Braham Parkash.

It was contended that it is a case of version and cross version. Version of the petitioner's side was lodged as FIR No.17/2016 on the day of occurrence itself while the cross version of the other party lodged after a delay of 3 days by way of aforesaid FIR. Both sides are stated to be relatives and the dispute is alleged to have occurred on the spur of moment over bursting of

crackers.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to order dated 17.02.2016, passed by this Court, the petitioner has since joined the investigation and fully cooperated.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Dinesh Kumar, does not refute the aforesaid factual position and further states that the petitioner is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted to the petitioner by this Court's order dated 17.02.2016, is made absolute.

Disposed of.
