In pursuance to the order dated 15.3.2016, passed by this Court, a response by way of affidavit of Dy.S.P., Fatehgarh Churian, Police District, Batala has been filed in Court today along with Annexure R-1. Same is taken on record and a complete copy has been furnished to learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

Perusal of the reply would reveal that the petitioner is a habitual offender and is involved in six other F.I.Rs.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from S.I Lakhwinder Kumar further submits that the petitioner having evaded the process of law has been declared a Proclaimed Offender in F.I.R No.20 dated 26.3.2015 under sections 307, 323, 34, 148, 149 I.P.C read with sections 25, 54, 59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station, Sekhwan.

Conduct of the petitioner disentitles him from the concession of pre-arrest bail.

Petition, accordingly, is dismissed.
