For having been found in possession of commercial quantity of weighing Charas 2 Kg 100 grams, the petitioner has suffered detention for one year as under trial. Out of 11 witnesses, only one prosecution witness stands examined.

State counsel informs that earnest endeavor would be made to examine all the prosecution witnesses.

This petition is dismissed at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to approach this Court again in case the prosecution agency is not able to examine all the prosecution witnesses, within a period of 5 months from the next date of hearing. The trial Court shall make earnest endeavor to record the statements of all prosecution witnesses, within a period of 5 months after the next date of hearing. In case all the witnesses are not examined within a period of 5 months from the next date of hearing, it will be open to the petitioner to approach this Court again for bail.
