JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been filed under section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure praying seeking protection to the life and liberty of petitioner at the hands of respondent No.6.

Notice of motion to respondent No.3 only at this stage.

At the asking of Court Mr. R.P.S. Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.3. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though a complaint/representation dated 12.01.2016 (Annexure-P1) was moved to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, but till date no action has been taken on the said representation. The petitioner confines his

prayer only to the disposal of representation(Annexure-P1) dated 12.01.2016.

Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation (Annexure-P1) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
