Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents no.1 to 3 to provide adequate security for the protection of life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents no.6 to 9.

It has been alleged that respondent no.5 is threatening the petitioner at the instance of respondents no.6 to 9 in order to mount pressure upon him to compromise the matter in case FIR No.234, dated 9.10.2011 under Sections 307/120-B IPC and 25

Arms Act registered at Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar at the instance of the petitioner.

On notice of motion having been issued, reply by way of affidavit of Balkar Singh (PPS), DSP, Sub Division, Nakodar, Jalandhar, on behalf of respondents no.1 to 5, has been filed and the averments made in this petition have been denied. Para 4 of the preliminary submissions in the reply reads as under:-

“That respondent no.5 never threatened the petitioner to implicate him in false NDPS case and the petitioner has levelled false allegations against the respondent no.5, moreover, petitioner is not required in any criminal case with the answering respondent as such present petition is liable to be dismissed.”

In view of the aforesaid, no direction is required to be issued in the present petition and the same is disposed of, as such.
