This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to official respondents to take legal action against private respondents. It is stated that the petitioner had moved an application dated 5.8.2015 (Annexure-P-5) to the Incharge, Police Post, Chak Duhewala, Police Station Sadar, Sri Muktsar Sahib (respondent No. 5), and another application dated 3.10.2015 (Annexure-P-6) to the Director General of Police, Punjab, Police Headquarters, Sector-9, Chandigarh, but no action has been taken so far on the same.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has moved a complaint before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib.

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In these circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to appear before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib, who is directed to look into the matter and take necessary action in accordance with law, without being influenced by the fact that the petitioner has approached this Court. If the petitioner is still aggrieved, he can always approach the Illaqa Magistrate with a criminal complaint.
