Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

Pusuant to the order dated 17.02.2016 passed by this Court, learned counsel for the petitoners has produced a photocopy of FDR for an amount of Rs.2,00,000/- for a term of three years in the name of petitioner No.1-Harpreet Kaur. The same is taken on record. He submits that the families of petitioners have reconciled the matter and now they do not have any threat to their life and liberty from the other side.

Learned counsel for the State has filed short reply by way of affidavit of Madan Lal, Deputy Superintendent of Police,

Yamuna Nagar on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, which is taken on record. Along with the reply, true translated copies of statements of Harpreet Kaur and Rupinder Kumar(petitioners herein) as well as statement of Sukhwinder Singh-respondent No.4(father of petitioner No.1) are also appended . A perusal of these statements shows that both the families have compromised the matter and petitioners do not need any police protection.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and same is accordingly disposed of.
