For having been found in possession of 2800 tablets of intoxicating powder containing diphenoxylate hydrochloride, the petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 28.03.2015.

The quantity being commercial, the provisions of Section 37 of the NDPS Act would be attracted.

No ground is made out for grant of regular bail.

Petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to approach this Court again for grant of bail in case the trial is not concluded within a period of six months after the next date of hearing.
