Petitioner has lodged an FIR against the private respondents on 22.08.2015 under Sections 382, 452, 323 IPC registered at Police Station City Sunam, District Sangrur.

Through instant petition, petitioner claims that on 23.01.2016 the said persons have taken forcible possession of the house and taken away the luggage belonging to the petitioner. In support of her contention, she relies upon the photographs of CCTV camera Annexure P-3.

Through instant petition, she seeks a direction for appropriate action against the private respondents.

The petitioner appears to have not submitted any representation to Senior Superintendent of Police, Sagrur or any other senior police authority reflecting her grievances.

The petition is thus pre-mature. Let petitioner approach senior police officers for necessary action against the private respondents. In case, any such representation is filed, it is expected that same would be looked into.

This petition is disposed of as not maintainable being pre-mature.
