Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Parveen Kumar @ Pennu in case FIR No.39 dated 1.4.2015 under Sections 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act registered with Police Station Harike, District Tarn Taran.

There was recovery of 50 grams of intoxicating powder from the petitioner and he was enlarged on bail. Due to solitary absence on 4.12.2015 owing to his illness, as per medical certificate P-4 his bail bonds have been cancelled and nonailable warrants issued.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for petitioner submits that pursuant to the directions passed by this Court vide order dated

18.02.2016, petitioner has surrendered himself before the trial Court on 25.02.2016 and was granted interim bail.

In view of the above, bail granted by the trial Court vide order dated 25.02.2016 pursuant to the interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 18th of February, 2016 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
