This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in Cross Version in case FIR No.64 dated 24.06.2015, registered under Sections 324, 323, 34 IPC, at P.S.

Gidderbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, vide Rapat No.25 dated

22.06.2015 registered under Sections 323, 325, 148, 149 IPC & Rapat No.6 dated 04.07.2015 registered under Sections 308, 328, 325 IPC, at P.S. Gidderbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

On 15.03.2016 the following order was passed:-

“Pursuant to order dated 04.03.2016, the parties are present in Court and they pray for more time to arrive at a settlement.

Adjourned to 27.04.2016 for further consideration.

In the meantime, accused/petitioner-Mayank Gumbar alias Guggu (in CRM-M No. 5955 of 2016), who is in custody since 27.10.2015, is ordered to be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Photocopy of this order be placed on the connected case(s). ”

On the last date the complainant sought an adjournment.

Today none has appeared on behalf of the complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the co-accused have been granted the concession of anticipatory bail.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from ASI Bagga Singh has accepted this fact.

In this view of the matter, I see no reason to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Petition is allowed. Interim bail granted by order dated 15.03.2016 is made absolute.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
