JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Rohtash @ Tasha in case FIR No.128 dated 18.04.2004 for offences punishable under Sections 148, 149, 332, 353 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Pehowa, District Kurukshetra.

A dispute at Veterinary Hospital in the village over supply of medicines for animals had occurred between complainant Yashbir Singh and main co-accused Jasbir Singh. The role attributed to the petitioner is of inflicting fist blows.

It is contended that no doubt, the petitioner has failed in joining proceedings leading to him being declared a proclaimed offender, the rest of

the co-accused have been honourably acquitted except the main accused Jasbir who has been released on probation. It is further contended that the petitioner is stated to be employed in Paris and is desirous of facing the trial.

Learned Counsel for the Petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim directions passed by this Court vide order dated 18.02.2016, Petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and has been granted interim bail vide order dated 02.03.2016.

Learned State Counsel assisted by SI Ramesh Chand is unable to refute the aforesaid submissions.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted by the trial Court vide order dated 02.03.2016 pursuant to the directions passed by this Court vide order dated 18st of February, 2016 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
