INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeking quashing of the order dated 19.03.2014, passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar, vide which the application under Section 311 Cr.P.C. filed by the petitioner has been dismissed and the order dated 09.10.2015, passed by the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Jalandhar vide which the revision petition filed by the petitioner against the order dated 19.03.2014 was also dismissed.

At the time of arguments, it has been brought to the notice of this Court that the complaint filed by the petitioner has already been dismissed and the accused has been discharged and that discharge order has been separately challenged before this Court in which notice of motion has been issued.

As the main case has already been decided by the learned trial Court, therefore, the instant petition, challenging the orders dated 19.03.2014 and 09.10.2015, has become infructuous and is dismissed as such. However, it is made clear that if the

petition, filed by the petitioner, challenging the order regarding the discharge of the accused is accepted and the discharge order is set aside then the complainant will be at liberty to produce the evidence as asked in the application under Section 311 Cr.P.C.
