Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Kuldeep Singh in case FIR No.41 dated 4.7.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 411, 414 of Indian Penal Code, Sections 21/22/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, Section 25 of the Arms Act, 3.0 S-Act, Section 61/1/14 of Punjab Excise Act, 3/34/20 of IP Act and Section 14 of F. Act, registered with Police Station Kahnuwan.

As per allegations in the FIR, lodged on a secret information, petitioner along with co-accused is involved in dealing with narcotics, liquor and spying.

It is contended that totally general and vague allegations have been levelled, apart from the fact that petitioner is not even named in the FIR.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel assisted by ASI Kulwinder Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 19th of February, 2016 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
