This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'Cr.P.C.') seeking issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to transfer the investigation from Police Station Division No.4 as the Investigating Officer and the Station House Officer of Police Station Division No.4 have failed to discharge their duties in accordance with the mandate of the Cr.P.C. while investigating the complaint dated 02.12.2015 (Annexure P-1).

2. Notice to respondents No.1 to 4.

3. On the asking of Court, Mr. Arjinder Singh Sidhu, AAG, Punjab, has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he feels satisfied in case direction is given to respondent No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded by petitioners in their representation dated 05.12.2015 (Annexure P-4).

5. The instant petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar to look into the grievances unfolded by petitioners in their representation dated 05.12.2015 (Annexure P-4) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
