Petitioners-Ranjit Singh @ Ranjit Kumar, Sukhwinder Singh, Jasbir Singh, Raju and Prince have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.196 dated 04.08.2015, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur, under Sections 323, 324, 452, 427, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case.

Ms. Shivali, AAG, Punjab has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioners have already joined the investigation. They are not required for custodial interrogation. No useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioners to custody as they are already on interim bail, granted by this Court vide order dated 19.02.2016.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The interim order dated 19.02.2016 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
