Petitioner is attributed two 'kapa' blows on the arm and legs of Vipul Sharma.

Perusal of the police file indicates that the injuries on the person of Vipul Sharma attributed to the petitioner were not declared grievous as he had left the hospital against medical advice. The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 19.02.2015.

Without expression of any opinion on merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that he will furnish an affidavit before his release before the trial Court that he will not indulge in similar activity during pendency of the trial. In case of any such eventuality, his bail would be liable to be cancelled.
