Petitioner is an accused in case FIR No.17 dated 16.01.2015, under Sections 20/21/29/61/85 of the NDPS Act and Sections 13 and 14 of the Foreigner's Act, registered at Police Station Sector-5, Panchkula.

Presently, the petitioner is confined in Central Jail, Ambala.

Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking interim bail for a period of one week on the ground that she has to participate in the marriage ceremony of her real sister, namely, Sarvjeet Kaur which is fixed for 29.02.2016.

Upon notice of motion having been issued, two separate replies one on behalf of Superintendent, Central Jail, Ambala and the other on behalf of the Assistant Commissioner of Police, Headquarter, Panchkula have been filed.

Perusal of the replies would reveal that the factum of marriage of the sister of the petitioner on 29.02.2016 has been verified.

Accordingly, the petitioner is held entitled to interim bail for a period of 5 days commencing from 27.02.2016 to 02.03.2016.

Petitioner is directed to be released on interim bail subject to satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Panchkula.

Petitioner would surrender before the Superintendent, Central Jail, Ambala by 5 P.M. on 02.03.2016.

Disposed of.
