Petitioner has been granted concession of anticipatory bail by a separate order passed in CRM-M-11174-2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the complainant could not appear before the trial Court to make statement regarding the compromise having arrived at between the parties though he has admitted during the hearing of bail petition that the matter has been actually compromised. Counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to file a fresh petition.

Disposed of as withdrawn.

Nothing said in this order will prejudice the pendency of trial against the petitioner on the basis of supplementary challan. However, it will be open to the trial Court to record the statement of the complainant and dispose of the case expeditiously taking into consideration the statement made on oath in the Court. It will be appreciated in case the matter is decided expeditiously.
