Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of private respondents No.5 and 6.

2. Notice of motion to official respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.
3. At the asking of Court, Ms. Harpreet Kaur, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Haryana and Mr. Rajpreet S. Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.
4. At the very outset learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is given to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated December 24, 2015 (Annexure P-1), which has not been considered so far by respondents No. 2 to 4 and to take appropriate action in accordance with law. He further submits that a complaint

has also been lodged before SHO, Police Station Farakpur, District Yamuna Nagar-respondent No.3 as well as before SHO, Police Station Bheni Mian Khan, District Gurdaspur-respondent No.4 and petitioner is being summoned.

5. Accordingly, Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar as well as to Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, to get the matter enquired into and in case any substance is found therein, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
