The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 407 Cr.P.C. is for transfer the case No.161/2016 from Judicial Magistrate First Class, District Rohtak to District Court, Sonapat in FIR No.406 dated 24.06.2015 for the offence under Section 307, 34, 498-A and 302 IPC at Police Station Rohtak Sadar, Distt. Rohtak.

The brief facts of this case are that petitioner's daughter was married to one Bhupinder Singh Takdir and as per allegations in the FIR, Karambir, brother in law, Sunita, sister-in-law and Takdir Singh, father-in-law had burnt the daughter of the petitioner and she died by suffering 95% burn injuries. No arrest have been made and complaints have been made before the higher authorities through registered post on 05.08.2015 and 22.08.2015. The accused persons were pressurizing the petitioner to settle the matter.

On notice, reply has been filed by DSP, Rohtak, stating that

Station Sadar, Rohtak to Women Police Station, Rohtak and investigation of the case was carried out by Investigating Officer as well as SHO Police Station Women Cell, Rohtak and DSP (Detective), Rohtak conducted the investigation. During the course of investigation, the statement of petitioner, Bhupinder i.e. husband of deceased, Ravina wife of Satpal (sister of deceased and daughter of petitioner i.e complainant) and other villagers were recorded. The copy of statement of Satpal and Ravina was annexed with this petition as Annexure R-1 and R-2. During the course of investigation, Sunita wife of Karambir and Takdir Singh were found innocent and the case has been converted from Sections 307, 302, 498-A/34 IPC to Section 306 IPC against accused Karambir @ Lilu-brother-in-law (dever) of the deceased. The accused-Karambir has been arrested in this case as per order dated 21.12.2015. Challan was presented in the Court of Illaqa Magistrate/JMIC Rohtak on 02.02.2016 against the accused Karambir @ Lilu and Sunita wife of Karambir and Takdir Singh-father-in-law of the deceased put in column No.2 of the challan. The trial was fixed for recording of evidence on 26.04.2016.

Learned State counsel submits that out of 17 witnesses, 13 have been examined.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the matter and the present petition is hereby dismissed.
