KULDIP SINGH, J (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 9 dated 27.01.2003 registered under Sections 323/324/341 of the IPC at Police Station Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar and subsequent proceedings arising out of aforementioned FIR (Annexure-P-1) on the basis of compromise.

Report of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rupnagar has been received.

The learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rupnagar, after recording the statements of the complainant-Harjinder Singh and accused Manjit Singh, has reported that the parties have compromised the matter without any pressure, undue influence and coercion from any side.

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In view of the fact that the parties have compromised the matter, the FIR No. 9 dated 27.01.2003 registered under Sections 323/324/341 of the IPC at Police Station Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar, and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, stand quashed.
