Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

In FIR No.204 dated 21.11.2014, under Sections 279, 337, 338 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') (Section 304-A IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib, petitioner as well as complainant are seeking compounding/compromise and quashment of the FIR.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the rival parties, it is seen from the record that the statements have been recorded before the Civil Judge (Jr. Division)-cum-JMIC, Fatehgarh Sahib and it has been reported that the compromise has been found to be genuine.

In that view of the matter, FIR No.204 dated 21.11.2014, under Sections 279, 337, 338 IPC (Section 304-A IPC added later on),

registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib along with other consequential proceedings, stands quashed in terms of compounding/compromise.
