Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral):

This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for the grant of bail to the petitioner in FIR No.776 dated 21.9.2015, registered under Section 394 IPC, Police Station Model Town, Panipat.

Heard.

The allegations against the petitioner are that he, along with his co-accused, snatched a motorcycle bearing registration No.HR-06-AE-0689, one mobile phone and Rs.150/- and ran away. He was arrested on 4.10.2015 and is in custody since then.

Today, State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Shamsheer Singh, has stated that another case is pending against the petitioner.

The offence is triable by the Magistrate. Challan has been presented. Since the disposal of challan will take time, further detention of the petitioner will not serve any purpose.

Accordingly, the present application is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bond

in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with like surety to the satisfaction of the trial court.
