JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner/accused-Roshan Lal in case FIR No.0004 dated 09.01.2016, under Sections 120-B, 406, 420, 465, 467, 468 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Civil Line, Kaithal, District Kaithal.

The petitioner is the principal accused, who is alleged to have constituted a Society registered in Andhra Pradesh but involved in the collecting of huge amounts from the unsuspecting people by sale of prospectus for a sum of Rs.1500/- on the pretext of providing training for Computer Education, Tailoring, Beauty Parlour etc. The petitioner/accused also alleged to have constituted another Society "Tan Media Trust" and vide the same prospectus, lured the people for providing jobs after training.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner heard at length.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by S.I. Randhir Singh, submits that the investigations are at standstill since none of the accused have been arrested.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence, it is felt that custodial interrogation of the petitioner would be necessary to have a fair and proper investigation.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
