Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.46 dated 13.03.2013 under Sections 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.

As per prosecution version the alleged recovery from the petitioner is of 265 grams of alprazolam. The same would be construed as commercial quantity. State counsel has further apprise the Court that the petitioner is a habitual offender and has been convicted for another offence under the NDPS Act.

No ground for regular bail is made out.

Petition dismissed.
