The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 56 dated 16.05.2015 registered at Police Station Civil Lines Batala, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur under Section 304-B, 306 IPC (offence U/s 304-B IPC was reduced to 306 IPC in challan).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is the husband and he is in custody since 17.05.2015 and the statement of complainant had been recorded. It was urged that 5 months before the death a complaint was lodged by deceased against her father which was compromised and it was agreed that the father would not go to the house of the deceased and the police had investigated the matter and challan was presented under Section 306 IPC and the trial would take time.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the complainant has been examined and the trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
