Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents to fairly conclude the investigation in case FIR No. 264 dated October 19, 2015, under Sections 420, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Ferozepur, Ferozepur.

2. Notice of motion.
3. At the asking of Court, Mr. Rajpreet S. Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that though the above-said FIR was registered at Police Station Sadar, Ferozepur on October 19, 2015 but since then no action has been taken against the accused persons.

5. Aggrieved against in-action on the part of respondent No.3, a representation (Annexure P-1) was also moved to respondent No.2 on December 14, 2015 but despite that no action has been taken so far and accused persons are roaming freely and are extending threats to the life and liberty of the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, to enquire into the allegations unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated December 14, 2015 (Annexure P-1) and in case any substance is found therein, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
