Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to the respondents to conduct free and fair investigation either by some senior officer or by Crime Branch in FIR No.151/2012, dated 29.07.2012, under Sections 323, 324, 506 IPC. P.S. Sadar, Amritsar.

Reply by way of an affidavit of Kawaldeep Kaur, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, North, Amritsar City, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 has already been filed and the learned State counsel, on the basis of reply so submitted, states that the matter was enquired into and on the basis of recommendations made by the Enquiry Officer, the then Assistant Commissioner of Police, North, Amritsar, vide Case Diary No.4,

dated 15.03.2013 (Annexure R-1/T), recommended untraced report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. in the case which has already been prepared by SHO P.S. Sadar, Amritsar on 09.08.2014.

In view of the fact that the police has already conducted investigation in the case, the present petition no more survives and same is dismissed as such.

The petitioner is at liberty to avail any legal remedy as available under law.
